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<u>The Twin</u>

John 20:24-31 ²⁴Now Thomas called Didymus, one of the Twelve, was not with the disciples when Jesus came. ²⁵So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he replied, "Unless I see the nail marks in His hands, and put my finger where the nails have been, and put my hand into His side, I will never believe." ²⁶Eight days later, His disciples were once again inside with the doors locked, and Thomas was with them. Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." ²⁷Then Jesus said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and look at My hands. Reach out your hand and put it into My side. Stop doubting and believe." ²⁸Thomas replied, "My Lord and my God!" ²⁹Jesus said to him, "Because you have seen Me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." ³⁰Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book. ³¹But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name. (BSB)

 - **B.** He did not experience the first event in the *upper room*. V. 24
 - C. He *heard* from the other Disciples that Jesus had appeared to them. V. 25
 - D. He refused to believe unless he experienced it *firsthand*. V. 25
 - E. He was in a locked room with the other Disciples when The Prince of Shalom <u>visited</u> them. V. 26
 - F. Jesus invited Thomas to personally experience that it was indeed Him. V. 27
 - G. Thomas proclaimed the saving *declaration* about Jesus. V.28
 - H. Jesus stated that it takes more faith to believe without *seeing*. V.29
 - I. We are of those who believe what was written down in *Scripture*. V. 30
 - J. <u>True belief</u> leads to a full, abundant life both in the future and for now. V. 31
- II. Why is Thomas's encounter so important?
 - A. Our <u>upbringing</u> does not have to limit us. Thomas had a twin and he was not one of the twelve!
 - **B.** We all do not need to have the <u>same</u> spiritual experiences.
 - **C.** It is important to learn from <u>other</u> people about their faith journey.
 - D. <u>Shalom</u> is available to us as believers.
 - **E.** We must proclaim the <u>*deity*</u> and humanity of our Lord.
 - **F.** We must receive the *<u>abundant</u>* life that God has for us.
 - G. Thomas went on to preach the Gospel in India. Our <u>journey</u> does not have to be like others around us.
