## The Message of Works

John 10:22-42 <sup>22</sup>At that time the Feast of Dedication took place in Jerusalem. It was winter, <sup>23</sup> and Jesus was walking in the temple courts in Solomon's Colonnade. <sup>24</sup> So the Jews gathered around Him and demanded, "How long will You keep us in suspense? If You are the Christ, tell us plainly." <sup>25</sup>"I already told you," Jesus replied, "but you did not believe. The works I do in My Father's name testify on My behalf. <sup>26</sup>But because you are not My sheep, you refuse to believe. <sup>27</sup>My sheep listen to My voice; I know them, and they follow Me. <sup>28</sup>I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one can snatch them out of My hand. <sup>29</sup>My Father who has given them to Me is greater than all. No one can snatch them out of My Father's hand. <sup>30</sup>I and the Father are one." <sup>31</sup>At this, the Jews again picked up stones to stone Him. <sup>32</sup>But Jesus responded, "I have shown you many good works from the Father. For which of these do you stone Me?" <sup>33</sup>"We are not stoning You for any good work," said the Jews, "but for blasphemy, because You, who are a man, declare Yourself to be God." <sup>34</sup>Jesus replied, "Is it not written in your Law: 'I have said you are gods'? 35 If he called them gods to whom the word of God came—and the Scripture cannot be broken— <sup>36</sup>then what about the One whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world? How then can you accuse Me of blasphemy for stating that I am the Son of God? <sup>37</sup>If I am not doing the works of My Father, then do not believe Me. <sup>38</sup>But if I am doing them, even though you do not believe Me, believe the works themselves, so that you may know and understand that the Father is in Me, and I am in the Father." <sup>39</sup>At this, they tried again to seize Him, but He escaped their grasp. <sup>40</sup>Then Jesus went back across the Jordan to the place where John had first been baptizing, and He stayed there. <sup>41</sup>Many came to Him and said, "Although John never performed a sign, everything he said about this man was true." <sup>42</sup>And many in that place believed in Jesus. (BSB)

- **I.** Here are the details of this passage.
  - **A.** This happened during the Feast of the Dedication, which we know it as the Feast of *Hanukkah*. V.22
  - **B.** Jesus was in one of the few places that was still in existence of the original Temple that was built by *Solomon*. V.23
  - C. The Jews asked plainly for Jesus to state whether He was the Messiah or not. V.24
  - **D.** Jesus made it clear that His <u>works</u> declare Him to be the One whom prophecy said would come. V.25
  - **E.** Jesus made it clear that His <u>sheep</u> will understand who He is and what He is about. V.26-30
  - **F.** Jesus clearly states His <u>Deity</u> and they want to kill Him for it. V.31-33

- **G.** Jesus referred to the Old Testament to show that other men were called <u>'gods'</u>. V.34-36
- **H.** The supernatural works that Jesus was doing  $\underline{\textit{verified}}$  that He was the Son of God. V.37-38
- I. Many <u>believe</u> in Jesus! V.39-42
- **II.** What can we learn from this?
  - **A.** <u>Celebrating</u> cultural holidays are not evil within themselves. Jesus celebrated Hanukah even though it is not mentioned in the Old Testament.
  - **B.** Having a building that we <u>meet</u> in is not unbiblical! Jesus had a building that He used as a meeting place.
  - **C.** Our <u>works</u> should verify that we are who we claim to be.
  - **D.** The <u>real sheep</u> of Jesus hear His voice and follow Him. What is God telling us for this generation?
  - **E.** Never let opposition deter you from <u>obedience</u> to the Shepherd.
  - **F.** Our works will lead to *conversations*, be ready for them and make the most of every opportunity!
