Paul's View on Thanksgiving, Part 4

Il Corinthians 4:13-18 ¹³It is written: "I believed; therefore I have spoken." Since we have that same spirit of faith, we also believe and therefore speak, ¹⁴because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus from the dead will also raise us with Jesus and present us with you to himself. ¹⁵All this is for your benefit, so that the grace that is reaching more and more people may cause thanksgiving to overflow to the glory of God. ¹⁶Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. ¹⁷For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. ¹⁸So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. (NIV)

Psalm 116:9-10 ⁹I will walk before the LORD in the land of the living. ¹⁰I believed, therefore I said, "I am greatly afflicted." (BSB)

- **I.** Here are the details of this passage.
 - **A.** It begins with a quote from Psalm 116 that refers to a faith that is not based upon *circumstance* but on who our God is! V. 13
 - **B.** Our faith is based upon the historical fact of the <u>resurrection</u> of Jesus Christ. V.14
 - C. God wants to produce Thanksgiving in us through us receiving and giving the grace of God. V. 15
 - **D.** The daily renewal that comes through grace produces a <u>courageous</u> heart. V.16
 - **E.** We have an <u>eternal</u> glory awaiting us that dwarfs our current troubles. V.17
 - **F.** Our *focus* should never be on our trials but on God. V.18
- **II.** What can we learn from this?
 - **A.** We must <u>evaluate</u> what we are putting our faith in. It is not in money or science; it is in our Living God!
 - **B.** We must live in light of the *reality* of Jesus Christ.
 - **C.** Grace has got to be on our mind <u>daily</u>. This grace should be given to ourselves, to others, and even to God Himself.
 - **D.** The <u>big picture</u> of what God is doing needs to supersede what we would will to happen.
 - **E.** We need to have the faith to say verse 17 and to <u>mean</u> it!
