## How to Have the Best Results

**Proverbs 16:1-10** <sup>1</sup>The plans of the heart belong to man, but the reply of the tongue is from the LORD. <sup>2</sup>All a man's ways are pure in his own eyes, but his motives are weighed out by the LORD. <sup>3</sup>Commit your works to the LORD and your plans will be achieved. <sup>4</sup>The LORD has made everything for His purpose—even the wicked for the day of disaster. <sup>5</sup>Everyone who is proud in heart is detestable to the LORD; be assured that he will not go unpunished. <sup>6</sup>By loving devotion and faithfulness iniquity is atoned for, and by the fear of the LORD one turns aside from evil. <sup>7</sup>When a man's ways please the LORD, He makes even the man's enemies live at peace with him. <sup>8</sup>Better a little with righteousness than great gain with injustice. <sup>9</sup>A man's heart plans his course, but the LORD determines his steps. <sup>10</sup>A divine verdict is on the lips of a king; his mouth must not betray justice. BSB

Intro: What does the name the LORD mean?

- I. What are the details of this passage?
  - A. The first verse is very controversial. There are two interpretations. The first interpretation says that we are *puppets*, and that God controls what everyone speaks. The second interpretation is that the condition of our heart is *controllable*. V. 1, 5, 9
  - B. Godly council is needed in major *decisions*. V.2
  - C. When God is made the <u>center</u> of one's life the other details fall into place. V. 3, 7
  - **D.** God is **<u>sovereign</u>** and it is wise to serve him now. V.4
  - E. Change is *always* possible as long as you are still living. V. 6
  - F. <u>Contentment</u> overrides greed. V. 8
  - G. Our leaders will be held *accountable* to God. V. 10
- II. What can we learn from this?
  - A. We must deal with unforgiveness, lies and worldly priorities if we are to be what <u>God</u> wants us to be.
  - B. We must <u>seek</u> godly council through relationships, prayer and Scripture.
  - C. <u>*True belief*</u> in the LORD is the beginning of godly character.
  - D. The time to start godly change is *today*!
  - **E.** We need to <u>**submit**</u> to the authorities that God has put over us as long as it is within the perimeters that He has established.
