## God's View on Anarchy

Proverbs 28:1-10 ¹The wicked flee when no one pursues, but the righteous are as bold as a lion. ²A land in rebellion has many rulers, but a man of understanding and knowledge maintains order. ³A destitute leader who oppresses the poor is like a driving rain that leaves no food. ⁴Those who forsake the law praise the wicked, but those who keep the law resist them. ⁵Evil men do not understand justice, but those who seek the LORD comprehend fully. ⁶Better a poor man who walks with integrity than a rich man whose ways are perverse. <sup>7</sup>A discerning son keeps the law, but a companion of gluttons disgraces his father. <sup>8</sup>He who increases his wealth by interest and usury lays it up for one who is kind to the poor. <sup>9</sup>Whoever turns his ear away from hearing the law, even his prayer is detestable. ¹⁰He who leads the upright along the path of evil will fall into his own pit, but the blameless will inherit what is good. (BSB)

  - A. Obeying what you know to be true protects you from *cowardice*. V.1
  - **B.** Anarchy leads to <u>disorder</u> and <u>chaos</u>. V. 2
  - C. Oppressing the poor leads to many *cultural* problems. V. 3
  - **D.** The law-abiding keep the *wicked* from taking over. V. 4
  - E. Seeking YHWH leads to *justice* in a society. V. 5
  - F. Walking in *integrity* is the best route to take. V. 6
  - **G.** Moderation in a child brings *honor* to their parents. V. 7
  - H. Systems that pray on the poor will be <u>destroyed</u>. V. 8
  - I. Obeying God's word builds on the *relationship* that one has with God. V. 9
  - J. We must be setting good examples for others whom <u>YHWH</u> has put in our life. V. 10
- **II.** How can we apply these truths?
  - **A.** Be willing to <u>examine</u> what you know with what God's word really says. So much of our beliefs are mere religious traditions given to us from our parents.
  - **B.** Resist the culture of <u>anarchy</u> you see around you. Vote according to God's word and not our political opinions.
  - **C.** We need to seek a <u>balance</u> in the way that we exercise our civic duties. Sincere Christ-followers should not hate others!
  - **D. Obey** the laws of man as long as they do not violate the laws of YHWH.
  - E. Seek *moderation* in all things.
  - **F.** Fight against *injustice* as you fight against anarchy.
  - **G.** Our prayers become <u>stronger</u> when we are walking in light of God's word.
  - **H.** Find a young person to <u>mentor</u>. Pray for God to bring someone in your life that you can walk with.
