Romans 12:9-13 ⁹Love must be sincere. Detest what is evil; cling to what is good. ¹⁰Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Outdo yourselves in honoring one another. ¹¹Do not let your zeal subside; keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. ¹²Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, persistent in prayer. ¹³Share with the saints who are in need. Practice hospitality. (BSB)

- I. Here are the details of this passage.
 - A. Our love for others must be free from hidden agendas. V. 9
 - **B.** Our priorities must be <u>aligned</u> with what God's priorities are. V. 9
 - C. Our *connection* to one another must be as family. V. 10
 - **D.** We must seek to <u>*lift*</u> one another up. V. 10
 - E. We must finish strong by serving the Lord. V. 11
 - F. We must have inner strength that comes from believing that the <u>best</u> is yet to come. V. 12
 - G. We must have a *healthy* prayer life. V. 12
 - H. We must become sharers of what we have been blessed with. V. 13
- II. How can we apply these truths?
 - **A.** We can begin to renew our love for others by <u>reflecting</u> on the love that God has for us. It is hard to give if you haven't received.
 - **B.** We must deal with past <u>wounds</u> from family members. If your heart is hard towards family, it will be impossible to expand family to include fellow believers.
 - **C.** We must have a healthy <u>view</u> of ourselves so that we are not threatened by others receiving praise.
 - D. We must learn to <u>serve</u> because God has given to us first.
 - E. We must allow God's *future* promises to affect us right now.
 - F. We need to expand our prayer focus.
 - **G.** We must see our <u>*resources*</u> as God's that He has given to us to use for His kingdom.
