Deepening Our Connections

Romans 12:14-21 ¹⁴Bless those who persecute you. Bless and do not curse. ¹⁵Rejoice with those who rejoice; weep with those who weep. ¹⁶Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but enjoy the company of the lowly. Do not be conceited. ¹⁷Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Carefully consider what is right in the eyes of everybody. ¹⁸If it is possible on your part, live at peace with everyone. ¹⁹Do not avenge yourselves, beloved, but leave room for God's wrath. For it is written: "Vengeance is Mine; I will repay, says the Lord." ²⁰On the contrary, "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him a drink. For in so doing, you will heap burning coals on his head." ²¹Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. (BSB)

- **I.** Here are the details of this passage.
 - A. We are to bless even the undeserving. V. 14
 - **B.** We are to **empathize** with others. V. 15
 - C. We must do our part to get along with everyone. V. 16, 17b, 18
 - D. We must try our best to make friends with all types. V. 16
 - E. We must not seek *revenge*, even on the deserving. V. 17, 19
 - F. We must overcome evil with good. V. 20
- **II.** How can we apply this to our lives?
 - **A.** Our <u>language</u> matters. We must seek to use edifying words to even the worst people that we know.
 - **B.** We need to find ways to *connect* with the lost. This should include everyone that comes within your realm of influence.
 - **C.** We need to have two <u>standards</u> for acceptance. Believers and unbelievers should have different standards. Too many American Christians have this backwards!
 - I Corinthians 5:9-13 ⁹I wrote you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral people. ¹⁰I was not including the sexually immoral of this world, or the greedy and swindlers, or idolaters. In that case you would have to leave this world. ¹¹But now I am writing you not to associate with anyone who claims to be a brother but is sexually immoral or greedy, an idolater or a verbal abuser, a drunkard or a swindler. With such a man do not even eat. ¹²What business of mine is it to judge those outside the church? Are you not to judge those inside? ¹³God will judge those outside. "Expel the wicked man from among you." (BSB)
 - **D.** We need to make connections with <u>unbelievers</u>. Too many American Christians only associate with fellow believers.
