## Is God a Loving God? Part 2

**I Corinthians 13:5** It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no account of wrongs.

I John 4:9-10 <sup>9</sup>This is how God's love was revealed among us: God sent His one and only Son into the world, so that we might live through Him. <sup>10</sup>And love consists in this: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as the atoning sacrifice for our sins. (BSB)

- I. What are the details of these verses?
  - A. God is never \_\_\_\_\_. God will never speak or act in a manner that is offensive, indecent, or brings dishonor to those to whom He \_\_\_\_\_.
