## The Resurrection Series, Part 2: Hard Truths

I Corinthians 15:12-25 <sup>12</sup>But if it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? <sup>13</sup>If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. <sup>14</sup>And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is worthless, and so is your faith. <sup>15</sup>In that case, we are also exposed as false witnesses about God. For we have testified about God that He raised Christ from the dead, but He did not raise Him if in fact the dead are not raised. <sup>16</sup>For if the dead are not raised, then not even Christ has been raised. <sup>17</sup>And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. <sup>18</sup>Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. <sup>19</sup>If our hope in Christ is for this life alone, we are to be pitied more than all men. <sup>20</sup>But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. <sup>21</sup>For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. <sup>22</sup>For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. <sup>23</sup>But each in his own turn: Christ the firstfruits; then at His coming, those who belong to Him. <sup>24</sup>Then the end will come, when He hands over the kingdom to God the Father after He has destroyed all dominion, authority, and power. <sup>25</sup>For He must reign until He has put all His enemies under His feet. (BSB)

**I.** Here are the details of this passage.

- A. <u>False teachers</u> from the Sadducee branch of Judaism had infiltrated the early church. V. 12
- B. A *non-supernatural* Christianity is meaningless and powerless. V. 13-17
- C. If there is no resurrection from the dead, then there is no <u>hope</u> for those who have died. V. 18
- **D.** We are to be pitied if the benefits are just *practical* earthly life blessings. V. 19
- E. True Christianity has benefits that <u>far outweigh</u> just those that we get in this life.
  V. 20-21
- **F.** All dominion, authority and power will be <u>*destroyed*</u> by the Kingdom of God which Christ is the head. V. 24-25
- II. How can we put these truths into practice?
  - A. We must <u>believe</u> the truth of God's word.
  - **B.** The <u>rocks</u> of competing truths must be replaced by the truth in our minds.
  - We believe in a *supernatural* Triune God who is uncreated.
  - The word of God is without <u>error</u> and is still as powerful as the day that it was written.
  - We are <u>created</u> beings in a <u>created</u> reality. We are sons of Adam. We did not evolve from nothing.
  - This life is the <u>only</u> chance that we have to follow Christ. There is no reincarnation or multiverse.
  - Only faith in *Jesus Christ* will allow you to be saved from death.
  - Angels and demons *exist*, and we are a part of a spiritual *war* that is waging.
  - What we do and believe <u>matter</u>!
