**II Corinthians 5:1-10**

- I. Last week I mentioned that the Bible teaches that both the righteous and the wicked will be raised from the dead. Let's begin by looking at some of these passages.
  - A. **John 5:28-29**
  - B. **Acts 24:14-15**
  - C. **Revelation 20:11-12**
- II. Here are some key details from this passage?
  - A. The "we"/"us" that are mentioned in this passage are those who \_\_\_\_\_ in Jesus Christ to save them.
  - B. Our earthly body is equated with being a \_\_\_\_\_ and our eternal heavenly body is equated with being a \_\_\_\_\_ home. V. 2-4
  - C. The Holy Spirit working in us is \_\_\_\_\_ that we have this promise. V. 5
  - D. We live our life here on earth by faith that we will be given a perfect permanent body in the \_\_\_\_\_. V. 6-9
  - E. We will be held \_\_\_\_\_ for how we spent our life. This is officially called the Bema Seat Judgment. This is different from the Great White Throne Judgement. V. 10
- III. How should this passage affect our daily life?
  - A. We should live our life \_\_\_\_\_ to the Spirit of God.
  - B. We should \_\_\_\_\_ our energies from self-preservation to reaching those without Jesus Christ. This does not include "fixing" their sin issues, their political viewpoints, or changing their culture. Remember that the Holy Spirit comes in only after they are born again. He will correct anything that needs to change.
  - C. We need to examine \_\_\_\_\_ aspect of our life to see if there are things that we need to repent from because we will be held accountable for \_\_\_\_\_ thought, word, and deed.
