Dove-Vine Intervention #3 <u>The Enduring Message</u>

John 15:26-27 ²⁶"When the Counselor comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who goes out from the Father, he will testify about me. ²⁷And you also must testify, for you have been with me from the beginning.

John 16:1-4 ¹"All this I have told you so that you will not go astray. ²They will put you out of the synagogue; in fact, a time is coming when anyone who kills you will think he is offering a service to God. ³They will do such things because they have not known the Father or me. ⁴I have told you this, so that when the time comes you will remember that I warned you. I did not tell you this at first because I was with you.

Intro: We have talked about the HS in these past two weeks. Now we look at the permanent message that He has been speaking and that we must continue to speak.

- **I.** Jesus is prophesying about the birth of something new.
 - A. He is going to <u>send</u> us an advocate. (Paraclete) John 15:26
 - **B.** This advocate will give *testimony* of Christ. John 15:26
 - C. Those who were with Christ from the *beginning* will also testify. John 15:27
 - **D.** There will be a <u>separation</u> from Judaism. John 16:2
 - E. The protection of *Christ* will be lifted, and persecution will come. John 16:2-4

II. How has this shaped the last 2,000 years.

- **A.** Something <u>supernatural</u> has kept the church going. It is as if we have a divine lawyer constantly defending us.
- **B.** We now know <u>more</u> about Jesus Christ than even the 12 Disciples knew. We can see the "big picture" of history, and we have so much information available to us.
- C. We now have the canonized New Testament which is the written <u>voice</u> of the Disciples.
- **D.** Christianity is the world's *largest* religion.
- E. <u>Persecution</u> is a historical fact and a present reality.
 - From without by other religions and government systems that are <u>threatened</u> by us.
 - 2. From within by those who <u>fear</u> change and have not experienced Christ firsthand.
- **III.** How does this keep us grounded (stay on message)? John 16:1
 - A. We have the <u>security</u> of past guidance.
 - **B.** We have the written *word* to keep our doctrine and practice stable.
 - C. We know that persecution only *enhances* the cause.
