

**The Proverbs Series #2: Treasure Hunt**

**Proverbs 2:1-22**

**Disclaimer:** It is easy to get a works based salvation when you only go by the Old Covenant. We are under the New Covenant. However, this is still God's word and there is much benefit to studying it.

**I.** Here are some of the details to this passage.

- A.** We must value truth as one does a very valuable \_\_\_\_\_. V. 1-4
- B.** When we make \_\_\_\_\_ a priority then we have a clear view of God, and we discover what He expects of us. V. 5-6
- C.** When we base our \_\_\_\_\_ around God, He works in and through us. V. 7-10
- D.** When God is working in and through, we are \_\_\_\_\_ from becoming a doer of evil. V. 11-17
- E.** We receive \_\_\_\_\_ here on earth by having a godly worldview. V. 20-22

**II.** How can we apply these truths?

- A.** We must be able to defend our worldview from \_\_\_\_\_. Be careful in using only the Old Testament in defending what you believe. We are under the New Covenant, not the Old Covenant.
- B.** Grace and mercy must be an \_\_\_\_\_ part of your worldview. Humility is a key component of the New Covenant.
- C.** God working through a New Covenant \_\_\_\_\_ must include a concern for one's own morality and a deep passion for reaching the lost.
- D.** There must be obvious \_\_\_\_\_ between us and those who are not in the New Covenant. We must not be embarrassed by them, and we should be equipped to share why we do what we do.
