The Proverbs Series #3: Straight Paths

Proverbs 3:1-10 ¹My son, do not forget my teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments; ²for they will add length to your days, years and peace to your life. ³Never let loving devotion or faithfulness leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. ⁴Then you will find favor and high regard in the sight of God and man. ⁵Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; 6in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight. ³Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and turn away from evil. 8This will bring healing to your body and refreshment to your bones. 9Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your harvest; ¹othen your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine. (BSB)

- **I.** What are the details of this passage?
 - **A.** We must remember what God has already <u>revealed</u> to us. V. 1-2 We receive blessings when we do this.
 - **B.** Love must be our number <u>one</u> defining characteristic. V. 3-4 We receive favor with God and man when we act lovingly. The heart of reconciliation is a commitment to love.
 - **C.** Trusting in the revealed <u>truth</u> of God keeps our paths straight. A straight path is the shortest distance between two points. A crooked path is time consuming and exhausting. V. 5-6
 - **D.** We must put God's <u>direction</u> over our "self wisdom". Our flesh is deceptive, and our minds can be warped. V. 7-8
 - **E.** Honoring God with our <u>resources</u> brings blessings. V. 9-10
- II. What are some ways that we can apply these truths to our life?
 - **A.** Write down some of the hard *lessons* that you have learned both from past mistakes and from good choices. Review these so that you do not forget them.
 - B. Seeking the <u>highest</u> good of others even at our own expense sets us apart from other religions and provides a platform for speaking truth into the lives of others. John 13:34-35 A new commandment I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are My disciples, if you love one another." (BSB)
 - **C.** It is important that a disciple of Jesus Christ not try to display a spirit of <u>control</u>. Obedience to His word leads to His <u>control</u> over our life.
 - **D.** We need to find ways to <u>honor</u> God with our resources. This must be given to us from God. It takes courage for us to ask Him for direction in this. He will direct us.
