

**The Expectations of New #3:  
The Old New Covenant**

**I. Here are the details of the Old “new” Covenant**

**A. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Abraham**

**Genesis 12:1** Then the LORD said to Abram, “Leave your country, your kindred, and your father’s household, and go to the land I will show you. (BSB)

**B. The \_\_\_\_\_ Given to Abraham**

**Genesis 12:2-3** <sup>2</sup>I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. <sup>3</sup>I will bless those who bless you and curse those who curse you; and all the families of the earth will be blessed through you.” (BSB)

**C. The \_\_\_\_\_ of The Promises**

**1. The \_\_\_\_\_ Experience**

**Genesis 15:17-18** <sup>17</sup>When the sun had set and darkness had fallen, behold, a smoking firepot and a flaming torch appeared and passed between the halves of the carcasses. <sup>18</sup>On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, “To your descendants I have given this land—from the river of Egypt to the great River Euphrates—.” (BSB)

**2. The Seal of \_\_\_\_\_**

**Genesis 17:12-14** <sup>12</sup>Generation after generation, every male must be circumcised when he is eight days old, including those born in your household and those purchased from a foreigner—even those who are not your offspring. <sup>13</sup>Whether they are born in your household or purchased, they must be circumcised. My covenant in your flesh will be an everlasting covenant. <sup>14</sup>But if any male is not circumcised, he will be cut off from his people; he has broken My covenant.” (BSB)

**3. The Giving of The \_\_\_\_\_**

**Romans 2:17-18** <sup>17</sup>You who call yourselves Jews are relying on God’s law, and you boast about your special relationship with him. <sup>18</sup>You know what he wants; you know what is right because you have been taught his law. (NLT)

**4. The Promise of a \_\_\_\_\_ Covenant**

**Jeremiah 31:31** Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah.

**II. What should be our response to the Old Covenant?**

**A. We must \_\_\_\_\_ the recipients of the original covenant that God had with mankind.**

**B. We must look at the \_\_\_\_\_ for the original commandments and fulfill the intent of each one!**

**Matthew 5:17-20** <sup>17</sup>Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets. I have not come to abolish them, but to fulfill them. <sup>18</sup>For I tell you truly, until heaven and earth pass away, not a single jot, not a stroke of a pen, will

disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished. <sup>19</sup>So then, whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do likewise will be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever practices and teaches them will be called great in the kingdom of heaven. <sup>20</sup>For I tell you that unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. (BSB)
