**Isaiah 43:10-13** <sup>10</sup>"You are My witnesses," declares the LORD, "and My servant whom I have chosen, so that you may consider and believe Me and understand that *I am He*. Before Me no god was formed, and after Me none will come. <sup>11</sup>I, yes I, am the LORD, and there is no Savior but Me. <sup>12</sup>I alone decreed and saved and proclaimed— I, and not some foreign god among you. So you are My witnesses," declares the LORD, "that I am God. <sup>13</sup>Even from eternity *I am He*, and none can deliver out of My hand. When I act, who can reverse it?" (BSB)

**Matthew 26:36a, 39** <sup>36</sup>Then Jesus went with His disciples to a place called Gethsemane. . . <sup>39</sup>Going a little farther, He fell facedown and prayed, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me. Yet not as I will, but as You will."

**John 18:2-9** <sup>2</sup>Now Judas His betrayer also knew the place, because Jesus had often met there with His disciples. <sup>3</sup>So Judas brought a band of soldiers and officers from the chief priests and Pharisees. They arrived at the garden carrying lanterns, torches, and weapons. <sup>4</sup>Jesus, knowing all that was coming upon Him, stepped forward and asked them, "Whom are you seeking?" <sup>5</sup>"Jesus of Nazareth,"
