Isaiah 43:10-13 ¹⁰“You are My witnesses,” declares the LORD, “and My servant whom I have chosen, so that you may consider and believe Me and understand that **I am He**. Before Me no god was formed, and after Me none will come. ¹¹I, yes I, am the LORD, and there is no Savior but Me. ¹²I alone decreed and saved and proclaimed— I, and not some foreign god among you. So you are My witnesses,” declares the LORD, “that I am God. ¹³Even from eternity **I am He**, and none can deliver out of My hand. When I act, who can reverse it?” (BSB)
